

Karl-Theodor zu Guttenberg has been a Member of the German Bundestag for the Christian Social Union (CSU) since 2002. His work as a Member of the Bundestag focuses on foreign policy and arms control. He currently serves as the speaker on disarmament, non-proliferation and arms control for the CDU/CSU caucus of the Bundestag. His area of expertise is Iran, where he has substantial experience including frequent travel to the country. He has been engaged in transatlantic dialogue on Iran's nuclear ambitions and he has also been part of a widely recognized working group on Iran.

Karl-Theodor zu Guttenberg serves as a permanent member of the Foreign Affairs Committee and has been recently appointed Chairman of the CDU/CSU caucus within the committee. He is also a member of the Subcommittee on Disarmament and Arms Control and a deputy member on the Defense Committee. Prior to his election to the Bundestag, Karl-Theodor zu Guttenberg was executive director of the Guttenberg company.
